Make a Balloon Globe

You need:

- ✓ cut-out continent shapes (attached)
- ✓ 9-inch blue balloon
- ✓ scissors and glue stick
- ✓ a thick, black, permanent marker
- ✓ a globe or world map (for reference)



Directions:

- **1.** Blow up and knot the balloon.
- **2.** Cut out the continent shapes.
- **3.** With the marker, draw the equator around the fattest part of the balloon.
- **4.** Hold the balloon with the knot on top. Glue Antarctica to the bottom of the balloon.
- **5.** Find the part of Antarctica that points out like a finger. This is the Antarctica Peninsula. Glue South America above the Antactica Peninsula. South America touches the equator.
- **6.** Glue North America above South America. North America touches South America.
- **7.** Put your hand on North America. Asia is exactly on the other side of the balloon globe. Glue Asia-Europe so that it is almost entirely above the equator.
- **8.** Africa is below Europe. It almost touches Europe. Find the top part of west Africa that juts out like an elbow. The equator should be below this elbow.
- **9.** Glue Australia below the eastern part of Asia.
- **10.** Put an X on the map to mark where you live.
