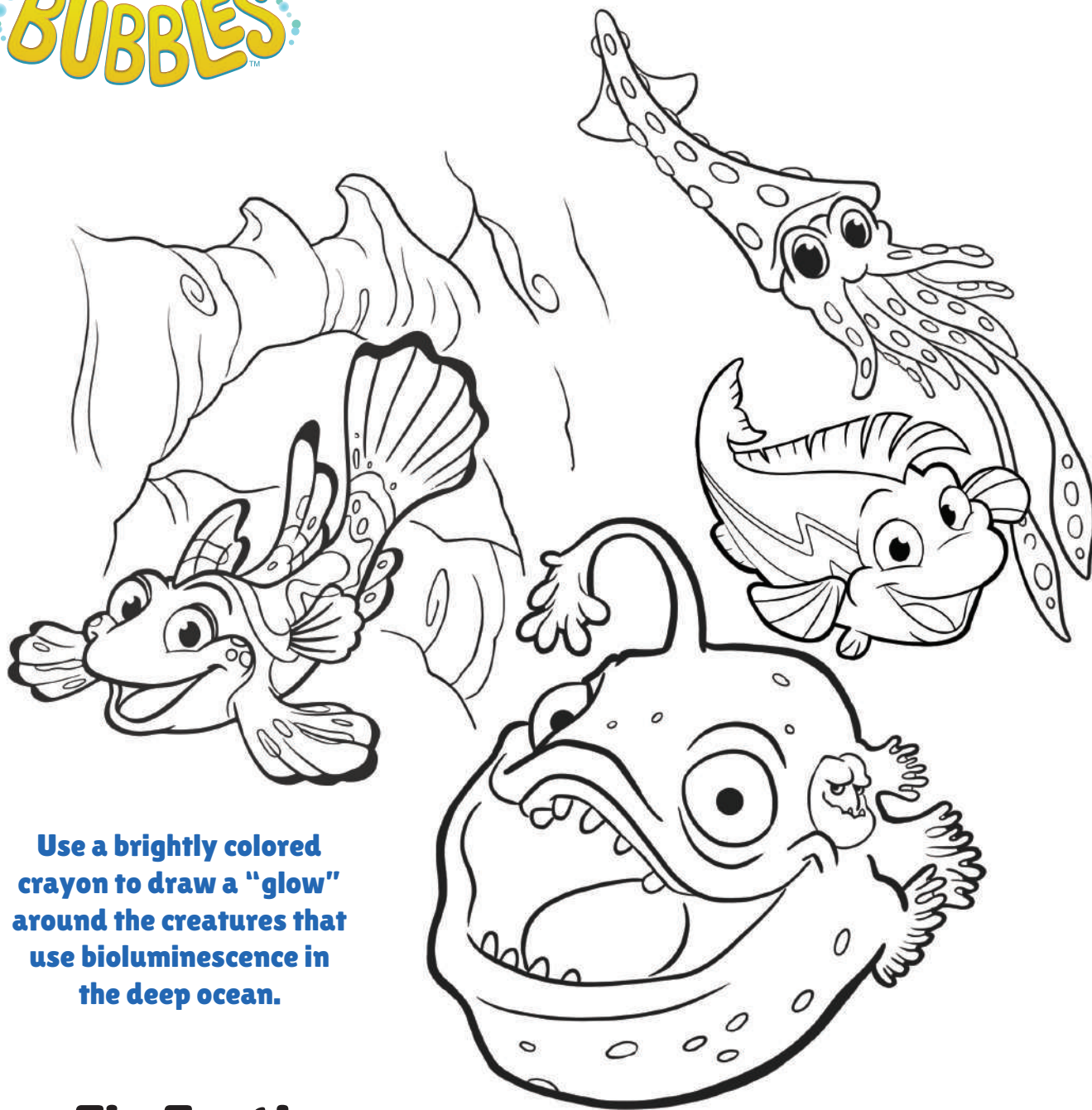


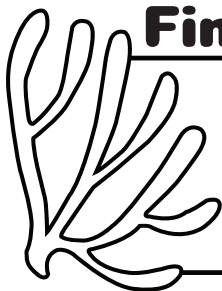


Splash and Bubbles are exploring down in the deep. It's dark! How do fish see in the deep?

Bioluminescence is caused by a bacteria that sustains a symbiotic relationship with its respective sea creature. These animals use bioluminescence to attract or confuse prey and provide light.
