You Need

- 2 wide-mouth, plastic bottles
 Marker
- Construction paper

- Paste
 - Scissors



To Make the Bank

1. Wrap tape around both bottles. (Have a friend help you.)

• Tape

- 2. Make a wide strip from blue-green construction paper that wraps around both bottles as shown at left. Be sure you can see the necks of the bottles. Do not tape in place yet. Lay strip flat.
- **3.** Cut out these shapes from construction paper:
 - **1 black rectangle**
 - 4 thin, black strips
 - 2 white ovals
 - 2 yellow ovals (larger than the white ovals)
 - 1 red hot dog shape
 - 2 orange rectangles (to wrap around bottle necks)
 - 2 white triangles
- 4. Paste the shapes on the blue-green paper to make Buzz's face.
- 5. Draw Buzz's eyeballs and a line across his mouth. Add teeth.
- 6. Wrap Buzz's face around the bottles. Tape or paste in place. (Add arms and legs if you like.)
- **1.** Label the orange rectangles **SAVING** and **SPENDING**. Wrap them around the bottle necks to make Buzz's antennas. Tape or paste the ends together. Lift off antennas to add or take out money.
