Check off each item as you find it.

- □ Flower with 3 petals
- Flower with 5 petals
- Leaf with veins branching off from a long center vein
- Feather
- Plant with leaves alternating up the stem from one side to the other
- Plant with leaves growing on the stem opposite each other
- Rings in a puddle when you drop in a pebble
- Birds flying in a v-pattern

Go on a scavenger hunt to find patterns in nature.

Directions

- 1 Cut out the "Nature Scavenger Hunt" checklist and glue it inside a blank notebook. This is your Nature Walk Notebook. Decorate the cover.
- 2 Go for a nature walk and look for the items on the checklist.
- Check off items as you find them. Draw pictures to record what you see. As you draw, look for patterns—things that repeat in a regular way. For example, leaves on a stem can grow opposite each other, or alternate from one side to the other.
- What else can you find? On your next nature walk, record what you see in your Nature Walk Notebook.

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
