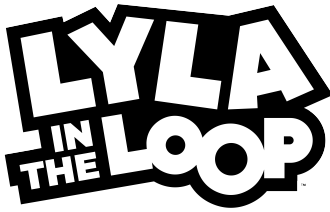

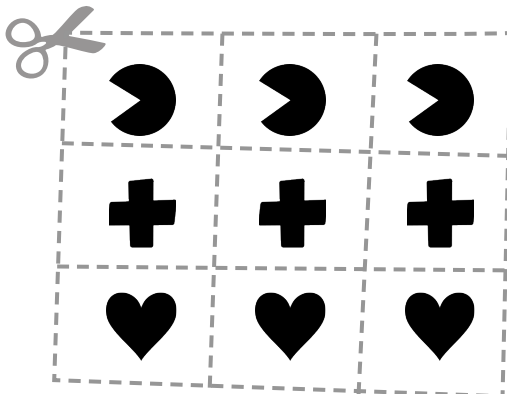

Cut Out the Rule Symbols

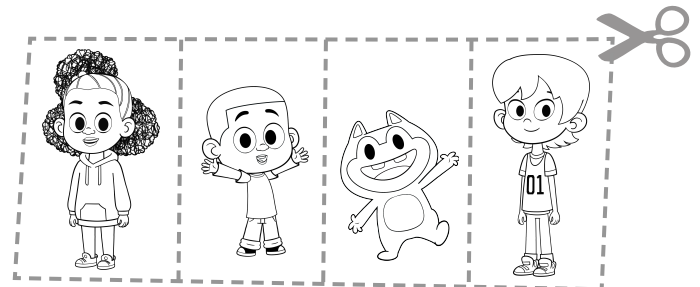
Glue them on any spot you'd like on the game board (on Page 1).
