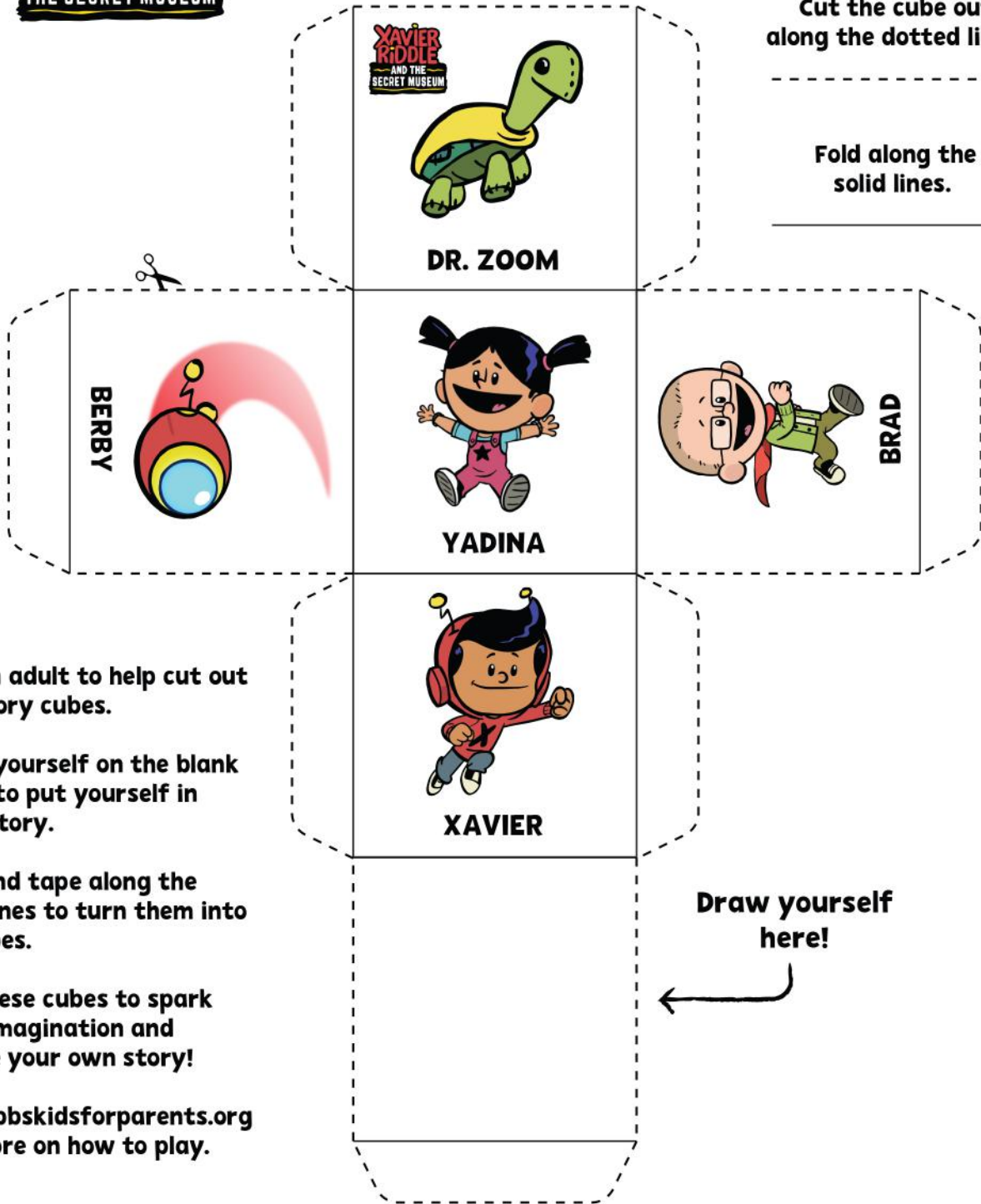




# Story Cubes

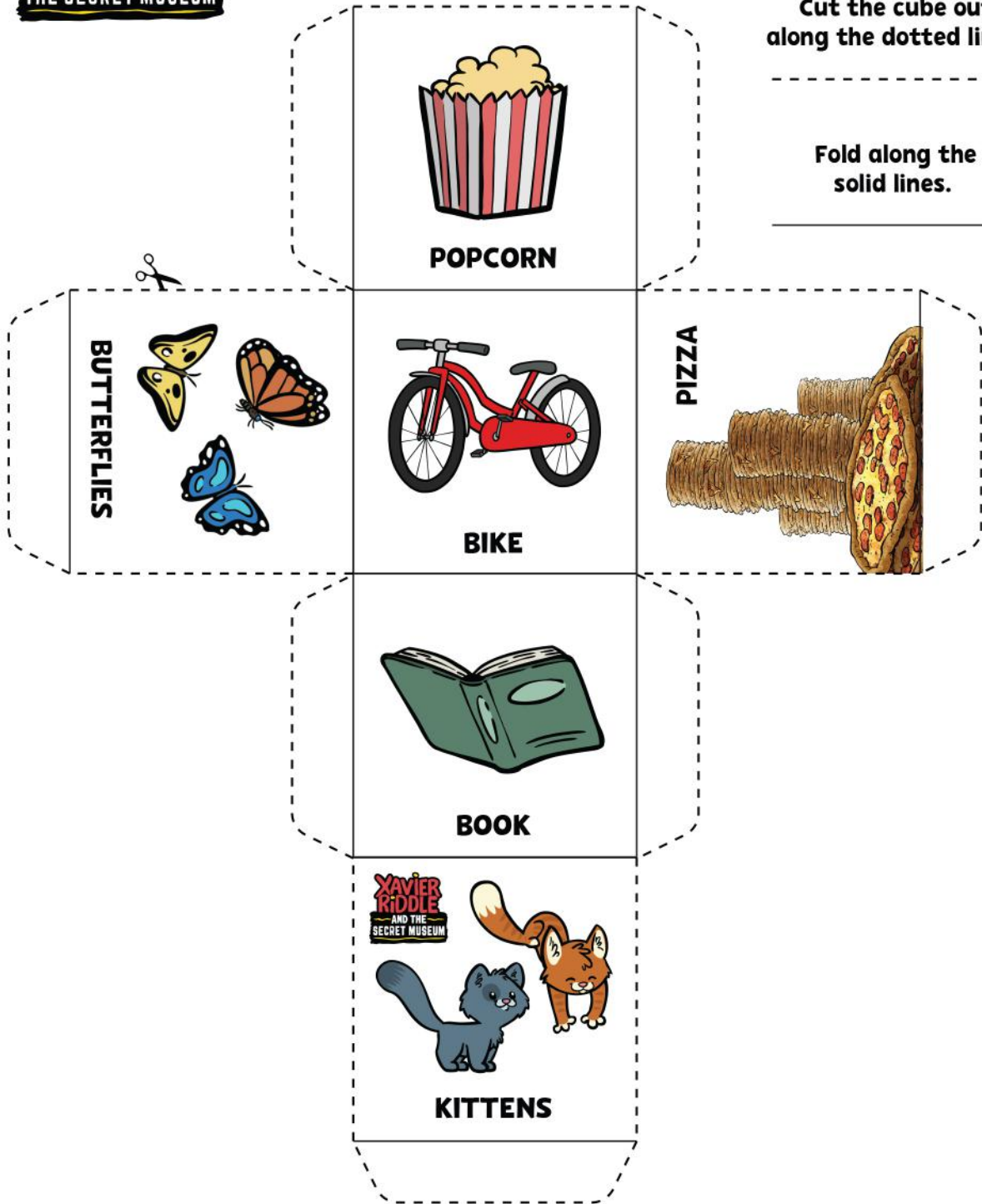

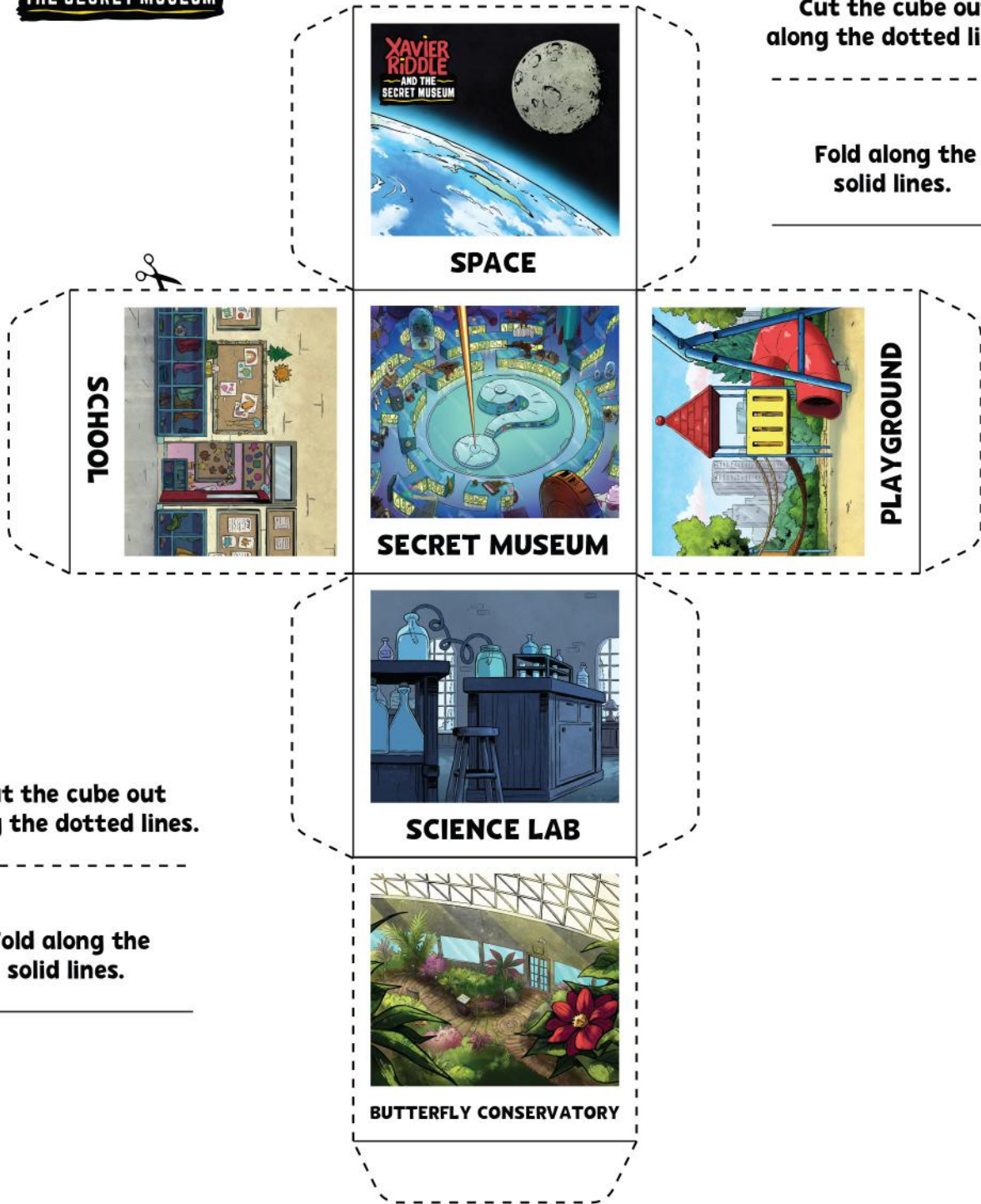
