Materials

- \Box 3 x 5 index card
- 12-inch piece of string
- "Make a Wind Gauge" handout
- small paper clip
- glue sticks
- hole punch
- □ scissors



Make a Wind Gauge

How fast is the wind blowing? Use this Wind Gauge to find out!

Directions

- 1 Glue your Wind Gauge to an index card.
- Make a hole where the black dot is. Tie the string through the hole.
- 3 Attach a paper clip to the other end of the string.
- Outside, hold the card so the string lines up with 0 (zero). Point the arrow toward the wind. What number does the string line up with now? That's your wind speed!
- Now find another place to measure the wind speed. Which place has the fastest wind?
